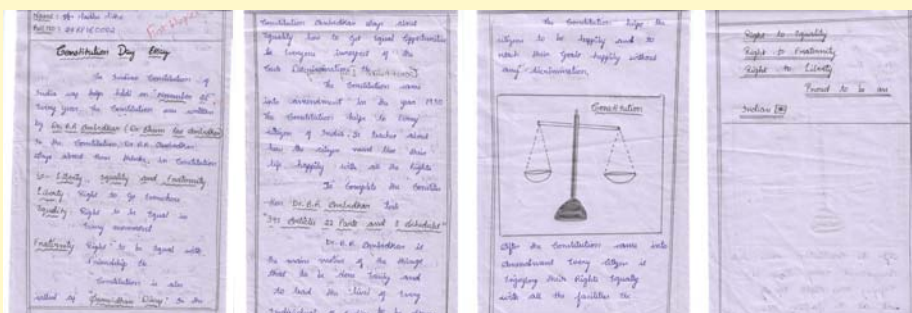

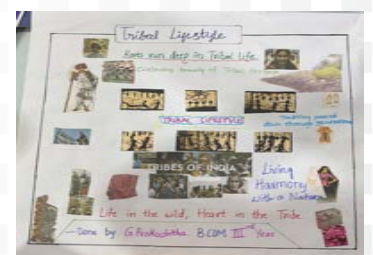

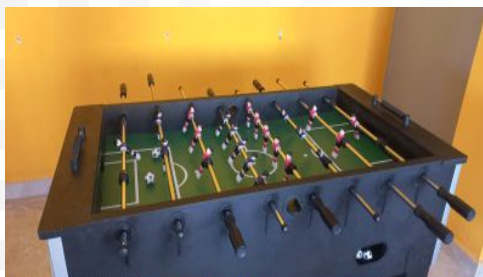

Constitution of India makes provision for functioning of democracy and not the electoral autocracy.

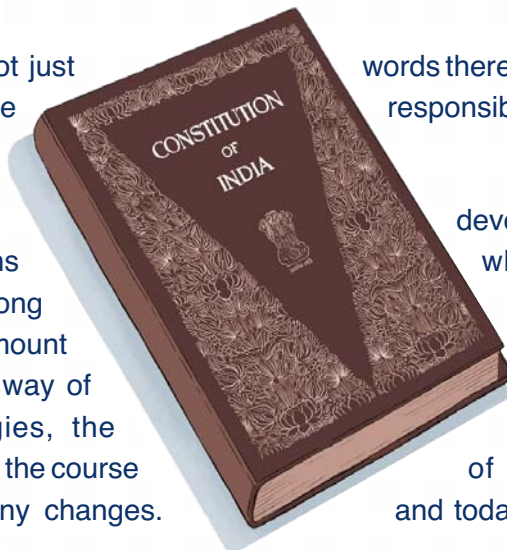
The Constitution of India (1949) opens with the words: “we the people of India, Do Hear by ADOPT, ENACT and give our selves this constitution “ ....
